<p>Course Load per semester</p>	<p>All depends on the needs of the students. Please note that most of the courses are worth 5 ECTS or 6 ECTS.</p>
<p>Language of Instruction</p>	<p>A majority of courses are taught in French language. We propose enough English taught courses for students with no French to complete an entire semester (or academic year). We also offer 4-5 courses in Spanish each semester.</p>
<p>Campus Facilities and accommodation</p>	<p>Our Institute is not located on a campus so we cannot provide/secure accommodation for students. But Lille is a great metropolis which offers many facilities and lodging for students.
